We aimed to assess the results of the treatment with trabectedin after platinum-based chemotherapy in a single center cohort. A total of 160 patients treated with trabectedin at our center were included in this retrospective analysis. Efficacy and safety data were collected from patients' records. Median duration of trabectedin therapy was 6.7 months (range: 2.1-29.3 months). The median progression-free survival and overall survival were 6.3 and 14.2 months, respectively. The response rates according to RECIST 1.1 were 59.4% of partial response, 23.8% of stable disease and 16.4% of progressive disease. The response rates according to IWG-SSG were 64.8% of partial response, 11.9% of stable disease and 22.8% of progressive disease. The median progression-free survival was 6.3 months in partial response, 3.3 months in stable disease and 2.7 months in progressive disease. The median overall survival was 16.2 months in partial response, 10.9 months in stable disease and 8.4 months in progressive disease. Quality of life analysis was performed by using the EORTC QLQ-C30 and QLQ-ST36. The toxicity of the therapy was mild and no toxic deaths occurred.
